General Eligibility

1 Eligibility Criteria for Admission into Undergraduate Programmes (B.A & B.Com)

Candidates should have passed any one of the following:

- a) The Intermediate examination or its equivalent.

(OR)

- b) 10+2 from the National Institute of Open Schooling (NIOS)

(OR)

- c) The two-year ITI course/Andhra Pradesh Open School (APOS)/Polytechnic Diploma, two-year vocational course, Veterinary or Agriculture Diploma, or any other equivalent qualification satisfying 10+2 years of study.

2 Eligibility Criteria for B.Sc. MPC / MPCs Programmes

Candidates should have studied Science subjects at the 10+2 level or Intermediate level.

- a) Intermediate, 10+2, or equivalent examination with Mathematics, Physics, and Chemistry (M.P.C.).

(OR)

- b) Polytechnic Diploma holders must submit the first-year marks list as proof of Mathematics study, along with the Diploma Provisional Certificate.

(OR)

- c) Vocational students must have completed Mathematics Bridge Courses.

3 Eligibility Criteria for B.Li.Sc. Admission

- a) Graduates with a minimum of 50% aggregate marks. A relaxation of 5% will be allowed for SC, ST, BC, and PH candidates.

(OR)

- b) Graduates working in a recognized library with at least one year of regular service in a substantial post of the rank of Record Assistant or above. An experience certificate must be enclosed.

(OR)

- c) Graduates holding a Diploma or Certificate Course in Library and Information Science from an institution recognized by the Government.
- (OR)**
- d) Graduates seeking admission under the in-service category must submit a service certificate in the prescribed format.

Recognized Libraries

Academic Libraries: Libraries of universities, degree colleges, recognized junior colleges, and high schools.

Special Libraries: Libraries of research and training institutions, libraries attached to industrial undertakings (State and Central Government, Joint Sector), and libraries attached to private-sector industrial undertakings recognized as public limited companies.

Public Libraries: Libraries established by an Act of the State Government.

School Libraries: Libraries in recognized high schools.

Private Libraries: Libraries recognized or aided by the Government (RC No. must be provided).

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
